## November & December What to see in the park

**Birds:** Look out for these.



**Barn Owls** Now it is getting darker earlier, you may be fortunate to see a Barn owl. They are very quiet and have a ghost-like appearance at dusk.



**Blackbirds** In autumn more blackbirds come to the UK from northern Europe. They like to eat berries and windfall apples.



As the leaves fall, wider views can be seen across the meadow.

## Small mammals



Hedgehogs are looking for a safe place to hibernate.



Grey squirrels are busy eating nuts and seeds.

**Fungi** Pictures from a bumper year for fungi in the park. There is a fascinating variety.
