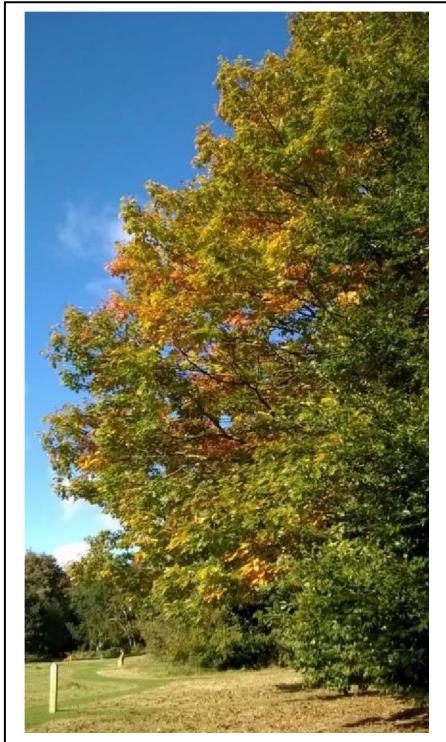
A hidden gem in the Chilterns

Fruit and nuts

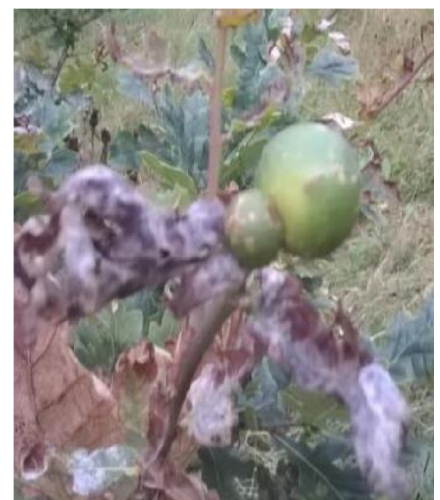


Elderberries
